R. S., c. 125, § 45, amended. The 11th line of section 45 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes dealing with Lincoln county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~four hundred dollars~~ \$450.'

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of County Commissioners of Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 43, amended. The 16th line of section 43 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes dealing with Lincoln county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~four hundred fifty dollars~~ \$500.'
