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**CHAP. 208**

**AN ACT Relating to Salary of the County Treasurer of Lincoln County.**

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 125, § 45, amended. The 11th line of section 45 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes dealing with Lincoln county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~four hundred dollars~~ \$450.'

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**Chapter 207**

**AN ACT Relating to Compensation of County Commissioners of Lincoln County.**

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 125, § 43, amended. The 16th line of section 43 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes dealing with Lincoln county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, ~~four hundred fifty dollars~~ \$500.'

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**Chapter 208**

**AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in Office of Clerk of Courts of Lincoln County.**

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$800, and such additional sum not exceeding \$300, when necessary, subject to the approval of the county commissioners; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$500; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, ~~two hundred dollars~~ \$240.'

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## Chapter 209

### AN ACT Increasing the Salary of Clerks in the Office of Register of Probate of Lincoln County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$800, and such additional sum not exceeding \$300, when necessary, subject to the approval of the county commissioners; for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$500~~ \$600; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$200.'

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## Chapter 210

### AN ACT Relating to Records of Oaths in the Office of Town Clerks.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Records of oaths in office of town clerks. A record by the town clerk that a town officer was duly sworn by the moderator in open town meeting in the presence of the clerk for a stated municipal office shall be sufficient evidence that such officer was legally sworn for said office and the recording of the entire oath shall not be required.
