use, distribution, and exchange as provided in section 17 of chapter 333 of the public laws of 1943, and for sale as hereinafter provided.

**Sec. 2. Price.** Subject to approval of the governor and council, the state librarian shall fix a wholesale price, not less than \$12, at which such revised statutes may be sold; and said state librarian shall thereafter make sales to bookstores at said wholesale price.

**Sec. 3. Disposition of proceeds.** All proceeds from such sales shall be deposited to the credit of the general fund of the state.

**Sec. 4. Repealing and amending clause.** All acts and resolves or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended to conform to the provisions of this act.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.

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## Chapter 362

**AN ACT** Relating to the Salary of the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Members of the Legislature.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

**Sec. 1. Salary of members of legislature.** Each member of the senate and house of representatives shall receive \$850 for the regular session of the legislature.

**Sec. 2. Salary of president of the senate and speaker of the house of representatives.** The president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives shall each receive \$1,000 for each regular session of the legislature, with the same mileage as the other members and subject to the same deduction in case of absence.

**Sec. 3. Salary during extra sessions.** When an extra session is called by the governor, the members of the senate and house of representatives shall each be paid \$10 for every day's attendance, and mileage as provided by law.

**Sec. 4. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$42,000 to carry out the provisions of this act. Any unexpended balance shall lapse to the general fund.

**Sec. 5. Inconsistent legislation repealed or amended.** All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed or amended to conform herewith. The rates of compensation hereinbefore set forth, are hereby declared to express the legislative intent, any inconsistent provisions in the 1944 revision of statutes heretofore enacted notwithstanding.

**Sec. 6. Effective date.** This act shall take effect on the first Wednesday of January, 1945.
