CHAP. 35

'Item VIII. Salary of judge; recorder provided for; salary. The judge of said court shall receive a salary of ~~\$800~~ \$1,500 per year from the 1st day of January, ~~1925~~ 1943, to be paid him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Cumberland county which shall be in full for the services as such judge. All blanks, civil and criminal, dockets and record books, required by said court, shall be furnished by the county of Cumberland. There shall be a recorder of said court who shall possess the same qualifications and be appointed in the same manner as the judge. He shall prepare and keep the records of the court. He shall perform all the duties of the judge but only when requested to do so by said judge or during his temporary absence or disability, or when a vacancy exists in the office of said judge. The recorder shall receive a salary of ~~\$300~~ \$600 per year from the 1st day of January, 1943.'

Sec. 2. Amending clause. This act shall be valid and effective, any provision of chapter 242 of the private and special laws of 1895, and amendments thereto, inconsistent herewith, notwithstanding.

Chapter 35

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Clerk of the Lewiston Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1921, c. 128, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 128 of the private and special laws of 1921, as amended by chapter 23 of the private and special laws of 1923, and by chapter 38 of the private and special laws of 1925, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Amount allowed for clerk hire increased. The clerk of the municipal court for the city of Lewiston shall receive an annual salary of \$2,100, with ~~ten hundred and forty dollars~~ \$1,400 additional for clerk hire from said city in monthly payments, which sum shall be in full compensation for the performance of all duties required of said clerk by law. He shall account quarterly under oath, to wit, on the 1st days of January, April, July and October of each year, to the treasurer of the city of Lewiston for all fees received by him by virtue of his office, specifying the items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the treasurer of the city of Lewiston, quarterly on the days aforesaid.'
