MONIES FOR THE EXPENDITURES OF STATE GOVERNMENT 19 PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1943 CHAP. 93

Chapter 93

AN ACT to Appropriate Monies for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1944.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves passed by the legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the said 90-day period will not terminate until after the end of the current fiscal year; and

Whereas, the expenses incident to the Special Session of the legislature are due and payable immediately; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriations for necessary expenditures of government. In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1944, the following sums or as much thereof as shall severally be found necessary, as designated in the following tabulations, are hereby appropriated out of any monies in the general fund not otherwise appropriated.
