## Chapter 49

## RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forest Commissioner to Cancel Deed Erroneously Recorded.

Forest commissioner authorized to cancel certain deed. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to cancel a deed to said commissioner of a certain lot reputed to be owned by Herbert E. Robbins, with the buildings thereon, near center of Township io bounded north, east, and west by land owned by F. W. Robbins; south by the Cherryfield road, not including small lot owned by Merton H. Leighton, containing 5.50 acres, in Township 10, S. D., Hancock county, as recorded in the state land office Volume 5, Page igo in record of deeds of lands sold for taxes.

The 194I tax assessed against the above described property and amounting to \$16.3I is hereby abated.

## Chapter 50

## RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Land to Enos Drumm, of Thomaston, Connecticut.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Enos Drumm of Thomaston, Connecticut, whatever interest the state may have in lot 128 in Township 1 , range 1 , NBKP (Rockwood) containing I acre more or less and having an assessed valuation of $\$ 300$, for the sum of $\$ 128.8$ I.

## Chapter 51

## RESOLVE, Closing Cobbossee Stream and Tributaries to Muskrat Trapping.

Cobbossee stream and tributaries closed to muskrat trapping. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing that portion of Cobbossee stream and tributaries thereto, located within the towns of Monmouth and Winthrop, to muskrat trapping for a period of I year.
