Chapter 72

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Burlington.

Resolve in favor of the town of Burlington, amended. Resolved: That that part of chapter 146 of the resolves of 1941 relating to the town of Burlington be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

Burlington. To aid in repairing the Lowell Lincoln road, so called, in said town of Burlington 1941-42 1942-43 500.00
