Chapter 166

AN ACT Amending the Unemployment Compensation Law as to Collection of Contributions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 24, § 14, sub-§ (a), amended. Subsection (a) of section 14 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'(a) **Interest on past-due contributions.** Contributions unpaid on the date on which they are due and payable as prescribed by the commission, shall bear interest at the rate of 1% per month from and after such date until payment plus accrued interest is received by the commission; provided, however, in such cases of delinquency as are shown to the satisfaction of the commission to arise from reasonable questions of liability under the terms of this act, the commission may, in its discretion, abate not exceeding 75% of the interest herein imposed. ~~Interest collected pursuant to this subsection shall be paid into the unemployment compensation fund.~~

Chapter 167

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Certain Oxford County Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 6, amended. That part of section 6 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salaries of the county commissioners of Oxford county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Oxford, ~~\$700~~ \$900.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. That part of section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of clerk of courts of Oxford county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Oxford, ~~\$2,100~~ \$2,300.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 79, § 146, amended. That part of section 146 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the county treasurer of Oxford county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Oxford, ~~\$1,200~~ \$1,450.'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the registers of deeds of Oxford county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Oxford, eastern registry, ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,800; western registry, ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,300.'

Sec. 5. R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the judge of probate of Oxford county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Oxford, ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,800.'

Sec. 6. R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of probate of Oxford county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Oxford, ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,150.'

Chapter 168

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the County Attorney of Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 130, amended. That part of section 130 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the county attorney of Oxford county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Oxford, ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,000.'
