## Chapter 187

### AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the County Attorney of Aroostook County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 130, amended. That part of section 130 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Aroostook county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook, ~~\$1,500~~ \$2,500.'

## Chapter 188

### AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of County Attorney and Register of Deeds, Southern District, Aroostook County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Aroostook county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds of the northern district, \$1,300; for clerks in the office of register of deeds for the southern district, ~~\$3,700~~ \$5,200; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$1,560; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$2,600; for clerks in the office of the county attorney, ~~\$600~~ \$1,000; for expenses of clerk of courts and his subordinates while attending sessions of the superior court at Caribou, such sums as allowed by the court.'

Effective July 21, 1945
