Chapter 214

AN ACT Relating to Tuition to be Paid by Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 90, amended. Section 90 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 90. Towns not obliged to pay tuition, except as provided by § 98. A town or union maintaining a class A high school as defined in section 89 shall not be required to pay tuition ~~under the provisions of~~ except as provided by section 98. A town or union maintaining a class B or junior high school as defined in section 89 shall not be required to pay tuition for any pupil until he has completed that part of the course or the equivalent thereof of said school approved by the commissioner except as provided by section 98.'

Chapter 215

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Clerks in the Office of Register of Deeds in Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of the 6th paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to clerk hire in the office of register of deeds in Hancock county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$1,500~~ \$2,500;'
