Chapter 224

AN ACT Relating to the Salary for Clerks in the Office of Register of Probate in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. The last paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to York county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'York county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$4,000; for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$2,000~~ \$3,080; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$1,750.'

Chapter 225

AN ACT Relating to the Amount to be Paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of the Recorder of the Municipal Court of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended so that said paragraph, so far as it relates to the amount to be paid for clerk hire in the office of the recorder of the Portland municipal court, shall read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of the recorder of the Portland municipal court, ~~\$2,496~~ \$2,912;'
