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**PUBLIC LAWS**

**1945**

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'Except as otherwise provided by law relating to part-time licenses, no license shall be issued to a restaurant unless it has been in operation as such for a period of at least 3 months next prior to the application therefor, provided, however, that any honorably discharged member of the armed forces of the United States who formerly held a malt beverage license or who formerly was the owner of a restaurant shall not be subject to the provisions of this sentence.'

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## Chapter 260

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Register of Deeds and Clerks in the Office of Register of Deeds in Androscoggin County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the register of deeds in Androscoggin county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin, ~~\$1,800~~ \$2,400.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of clerks in the office of register of deeds in Androscoggin county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$2,500~~ \$3,250.'
