Chapter 296

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of Judge of Probate of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of the 2nd paragraph of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of judge of probate of Hancock county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Hancock, ~~\$2,000~~ \$2,300.'

Chapter 297

AN ACT to Simplify the Financial Structure of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 14, § 184, amended. Section 184 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 184. Allocation of tax. All taxes collected under the provisions of section 172 ~~after the deduction of such amounts as may be currently appropriated to cover the costs and expenses of the state tax assessor incident to the administration and enforcement of the provisions of sections 169 to 185, inclusive~~ shall be credited to the general highway fund.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 15, repealed. Section 15 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 23, § 167, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 167 of chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All funds collected from this source shall be ~~expended for emergency tuberculosis work within the sanatoriums or private and semi-private hospitals~~ credited to the general fund of the state. No pauper disabilities shall be created by reason of any aid or assistance given under the provisions of this section.'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 25, § 62, amended. The last sentence of section 62 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
