Chapter 322

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of Various Officers of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. That part of section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Waldo county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, ~~\$1,400~~ \$1,800.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 130, amended. That part of section 130 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Waldo county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,300.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 79, § 146, amended. That part of section 146 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Waldo county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, ~~\$400~~ \$600.'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 79, § 165, amended. That part of section 165 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Waldo county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,800.'

Sec. 5. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Waldo county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,500.'

Sec. 6. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to Waldo county is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Waldo county : for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$1,560~~ \$2,080 ; for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$780~~ \$1,040 ; for clerks in the office of the clerk of courts, ~~\$800~~ \$1,040.'

Sec. 7. R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to Waldo county is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Waldo, ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,500.'

Sec. 8. R. S., c. 140, § 22, amended. That part of section 22 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to Waldo county is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Waldo, ~~\$1,200~~ \$1,500.'

Chapter 323

AN ACT Relating to Payment of Salaries and Wages of State Officers and Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 14, § 27, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 27 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'All state officers and employees, except temporary and seasonal employees, shall be paid their salaries or wages ~~fortnightly~~ weekly, the dates of payment to be determined by the state controller ; provided, however, that payment may be made once in each calendar month or ~~fortnightly~~ to such state officers and employees as consent to such time of payment. Temporary and seasonal employees of the state shall be paid at such times as the commissioner of finance shall specify.'
