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## Chapter 363

### AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Adjutant-General.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 12, § 12, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 12 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The adjutant-general shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$4,500~~ \$5,500; he shall receive no other fee, emolument, or perquisite. The provisions of this act shall remain in effect for the period of 2 years, after which period the present statute shall return to full force and effect.'

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## Chapter 364

### AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Commissioner of Agriculture.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 27, § 1, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 1 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'He shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$4,500~~ \$6,000.'

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## Chapter 365

### AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Bank Commissioner.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 55, § 1, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 1 of chapter 55 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'He shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$5,000~~ \$6,000, and his actual traveling expenses incurred in the performance of his duties.'
