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## Chapter 16

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Members of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lewiston.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. V, § 9, amended. Section 9 of Article V of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 9. Compensation. The members of the board of aldermen shall receive as full compensation for the performance of their official duties as aldermen the sum of \$10 for each meeting of the city council which they shall attend provided that no alderman shall be paid an amount in excess of ~~\$200~~ \$300 for such attendance ~~during~~ at any one term. Members of the board of aldermen when they shall convene for the purpose of constituting a board of examiners shall receive as full compensation for such duties the sum of \$3 for each meeting attended.'

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

'Sec. 2. Nomination papers. The signatures to nomination papers need not all be affixed to 1 petition but to each separate petition there shall be
