#### GIFTS OR LEGACIES TO JEFFERSON CARY HOSPITAL FUND 583 PRIVATE AND SPECIAL, 1945 CHAP. 41

#### Chapter 40

# AN ACT Relating to the Fire and Police Commission for the Town of Skowhegan.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1909, c. 247, repealed. Chapter 247 of the private and special laws of 1909 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. Certain powers to revest in town. The authority of the town of Skowhegan to delegate all its powers and that of its municipal officers relating to the inspection of buildings, a fire department, the prevention and extinguishment of fires, and its police officers and department is hereby terminated, and henceforth such powers shall revest in the town of Skowhegan and its municipal officers under the general laws of the state.

Sec. 3. Referendum. This act shall take effect and be in full force when the same shall have been accepted by the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in town affairs, at a legal meeting under a warrant containing an article giving notice thereof, provided it shall be accepted within I year from the date of approval.

### Chapter 41

#### AN ACT Enabling Board of Managers of the Jefferson Cary Hospital Fund to Accept Gifts or Legacies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1913, c. 20, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 20 of the private and special laws of 1913, as amended by chapter 95 of the private and special laws of 1915, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:
