Chapter 97

AN ACT Relating to Salary of the Recorder of the Municipal Court of the City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1903, c. 422, amended. That part designated "Sec. 2" of chapter 422 of the private and special laws of 1903, as amended by chapter 147 of the private and special laws of 1917, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Salary of recorder increased. For all services rendered, except when there is a vacancy in the office of judge, the recorder shall be paid from the county treasury the sum of ~~six hundred dollars~~ \$1,000 annually, payable on the first days of January, April, July and October, which shall be in full for all services rendered as such recorder.'

Chapter 98

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal Court of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1891, c. 150, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 150 of the private and special laws of 1891, as amended by chapter 61 of the private and special laws of 1925, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Salary increased. The salary of the judge of said court shall be ~~twenty two hundred dollars~~ \$3,000 per annum, ~~payable quarterly~~ beginning January 1st, 1945, in full for all services.'
