## Chapter 5

### RESOLVE, Opening Androscoggin Watershed and Tributaries to Smelt Fishing.

Androscoggin watershed opened to smelt fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to open Androscoggin watershed and tributaries, in the counties of Oxford and Franklin, to the taking of smelts under the general law.

## Chapter 6

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Pleasant Pond.

Fishing in Pleasant pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing that portion of Pleasant pond in Turner, county of Androscoggin, south of a row of stakes situated approximately 5 rods north of the outlet.

## Chapter 7

### RESOLVE, Relating to Old Bay Bridge Road in the County of Sagadahoc.

Old Bay Bridge road; set off from county of Sagadahoc. Resolved: That the Old Bay Bridge road leading from the Old Bay bridge to the County road and all the land and approaches to said Old Bay bridge that formerly crossed the Androscoggin river at Mustards Island, so called, which was set off from the county of Cumberland and annexed to the county of Sagadahoc by the act of the legislature in the year 1878, be, and hereby is, set off from the county of Sagadahoc and re-annexed to the county of Cumberland.
