Chapter 41

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Repair Fish Way at Aroostook Falls.

Fish way at Aroostook Falls; repairing of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,000 to be taken from the general fund of the state and expended by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, for repairing the fish way at Aroostook Falls on the Aroostook river in the Province of New Brunswick; said fish way to be repaired at the time said money, workmen and materials shall be available.

Any and all acts done in compliance with the provisions of this resolve in the Province of New Brunswick shall be with the consent and approval of said Province.

Chapter 42

RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold Harvey and Henry Marsh of Corinth.

Harold Harvey and Henry Marsh; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$327 to be paid to Harold Harvey and Henry Marsh of Corinth, as a full and final settlement for their claim against the state for sheep killed by bears; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.
