Chapter 91

RESOLVE, Providing for the Payment of Certain Damages Caused by Protected Wild Animals.

Damages caused by deer and moose to automobiles and crops; provided for. **Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$5,384.04 from the funds of department of inland fisheries and game to be paid to certain persons, as a full and final settlement for their claims against the state for damages to their cars, trucks and crops according to the following list:
