Chapter 106

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Land in Piscataquis County to Harry Greenleaf, of Norway.

Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. **Resolved:** That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Harry Greenleaf, of Norway, whatever interest the state has in Lot in south part of Sugar Island, bounded north by Hollingsworth & Whitney, south by Moosehead lake, and east and west by said company and lake, with buildings, containing 8 acres more or less, for the sum of \$282.99.

Chapter 107

RESOLVE, to Simplify the Ice Fishing Laws by Counties.

Commissioner of inland fisheries and game to issue certain rules and regulations. **Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized and directed to issue rules and regulations relating to ice fishing in certain lakes, ponds, rivers, streams and brooks, as follows:

In Androscoggin county:

Open to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.
