Chapter 250

AN ACT Relating to Tenure of Office of State Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 3, amended. The 1st sentence of section 3 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The state liquor commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of 3 members to be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, to serve for 3 years ~~or during the pleasure of the governor and council~~ and may after notice and hearing be removed for cause by the governor and council.'

Chapter 251

AN ACT Regulating Fishing for Smelts in Tidewaters of East Machias River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 35, amended. Section 35 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'It shall be lawful to fish for and take smelts from the tidewaters of the East Machias river within the town limits of Machiasport between the 1st day of October and the 15th day of May. Any fish so taken from said waters may be offered for sale and sold within the state or shipped to such places out of the state as the owner may designate.'

AN ACT Relating to Permits for Digging Into and Opening Streets and Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 84, § 115, amended. Section 115 of chapter 84 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 250 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
