CHAP. 325

Sec. 9. R. S., c. 31, § 22, repealed and replaced. Section 22 of chapter 31 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 294 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 22. Benefits, how secured; certificate of action. Any existing association formed under any law of this state as a cooperative agricultural association may elect, by a vote of 2/3 of the members voting thereon at a legal meeting, to secure the benefits of and be bound by the provisions of this chapter, and shall thereupon amend such of its articles and by-laws as are not in conformity with the provisions hereof. A certificate of the action taken at such meeting shall be filed with the secretary of state within 20 days after such meeting, and a fee of \$5 shall be paid.'

Chapter 325

AN ACT Relating to Billboards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 113, repealed and replaced. Section 113 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 113. Fees. The fees for such permits shall be \$2.50 for each panel, bulletin or sign the area of which does not exceed 100 square feet, and \$4.50 for each panel, bulletin or sign the area of which exceeds 100 square feet but does not exceed 300 square feet, and \$5 for each panel, bulletin or sign the area of which exceeds 300 square feet but does not exceed 700 square feet, and \$7 for each panel, bulletin or sign the area of which exceeds 700 square feet but does not exceed 900 square feet. The area of a panel, bulletin or sign shall include all finish mouldings but not lattice work or base trim used only for ornamental purposes. A fee shall be paid for each side of each panel, bulletin or sign used or intended to be used for advertising, and each panel, bulletin or sign of a series shall require a permit and the payment of a separate permit fee. All fees for such permits shall be payable annually in advance, such fees to become effective January 1, 1948 and thereafter.'
