CHAP. 388

section 298, as amended by chapter 271 of the public laws of 1945; sections 299 to 306, inclusive; and section 306-A as enacted by chapter 150 of the public laws of 1945.

Sec. 6. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state to carry out the purposes of this act, the sum of \$78,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948 and \$79,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949. Any unexpended balances shall lapse to the general fund.

Chapter 387

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Insurance Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 56, § 2, amended. The 5th sentence of section 2 of chapter 56 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'He shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$4,500~~ \$6,000.'

Chapter 388

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Adjutant-General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 12, § 12, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 12 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The adjutant-general shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$4,500~~ \$6,000; he shall receive no other fee, emolument or perquisite.'
