Chapter 164

AN ACT to appropriate Monies for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1947.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves passed by the legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, funds were not provided to cover the expenses of the 92nd legislature incurred while in special session; and

Whereas, funds available for legislative expenses are now exhausted, it is, therefore, necessary to provide additional funds for the increased operating costs of the current legislative session; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation for necessary expenditures of government. In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1947, the following sums or as much thereof as shall severally be found necessary, as designated in the following tabulations, are hereby appropriated out of any monies in the general fund not otherwise appropriated.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 165

AN ACT to Increase the Purposes and Powers of Bates Manufacturing Company and to Authorize it to Acquire the Assets of Bates Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bates Manufacturing Company to acquire certain assets. Bates Manufacturing Company, a corporation organized and existing under chapter 360 of the private and special laws of 1850, is hereby authorized to acquire
