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## Chapter 18

**RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Aroostook County to Ralph M. Robinson, of Sherman Mills.**

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Ralph M. Robinson of Sherman Mills, whatever interest the state has in a farm lot in the northeast part of T. 7, R. 5, W. E. L. S. Aroostook county, lying on both sides of the Ashland and Patten road, as shown by a survey and plan of said township made by Cobb & Robinson in 1900, containing 100 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$115.89.

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## Chapter 19

**RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Piscataquis County to Mabel I. Lafland of Medford Township.**

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Mabel I. Lafland of Medford Township, whatever interest the state has in undivided  $\frac{1}{2}$  lots E and W, N. of river in W. half of town, with buildings, (59A); also W. half of lot 53 and W. part of lot K, N. of river in W. half of town (56 A.), in Medford Township, Piscataquis county, containing 115 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$70.10.

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## Chapter 20

**RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Washington County to Alvah B. Alexander, et als. of South Gardiner.**

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain lands. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Alvah B. Alexander, et als. of South Gardiner, whatever interest the state has in a cottage lot bounded N. by Eastern Pulpwood Co.; E. and S. by Carlow

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brook; W. by E. arm of Clifford lake, with buildings, in T. 27, east division, Washington county, containing 1 acre, more or less, for the sum of \$23.57.

Lafland, as heirs-at-law of Iva M. Hathorn, deceased, late of said Medford Township, whatever interest the state has in undivided  $\frac{1}{2}$  in lots E and W, N. of river in W. half of town, with buildings, (59A); also  $\frac{1}{2}$  undivided in W.  $\frac{1}{3}$  lot 53 N. of river in W. half of town (22A); also  $\frac{1}{2}$  undivided in W. part of lot K, (34A), in Medford Township, Piscataquis county, containing 115 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$70.10.

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## Chapter 22

**RESOLVE**, Regulating Fishing in East Pond Stream, Town of Smithfield, Somerset County.

Fishing in East Pond stream, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing East Pond stream, from Wyman dam to North Pond, in the town of Smithfield, Somerset county, to all fishing from the time the ice goes out in the spring to June 1.
