**RESOLVE, in Favor of Several Academies, Institutes and Seminaries.**

**Appropriation for aid to academies. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the several academies, institutes and seminaries hereinafter listed the sum of \$33,700 from July 1, 1947 to June 30, 1948 and the sum of \$33,700 from July 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949, said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said institutions to the amount indicated.
