CHAP. 176

RESOLVES, 1947

Wayne. To aid in repairing the Pond road, so called, beginning at the end of state aid improved part to Pike's corner, a distance of approximately I mile

1948-49

Wesley. To aid in repairing the road beginning at the residence of W. A. Norton and continuing toward Wesley Corner. This is state aid route # 192

500.00

#### Chapter 174

RESOLVE, in Favor of E. E. Webber, of Rockland.

E. E. Webber, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$81.66 from the general fund of the state to be paid to E. E. Webber, of Rockland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

#### Chapter 175

RESOLVE, in Favor of Anson Academy.

Anson Academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Anson Academy the sum of \$10,000 from July 1, 1947 to June 30, 1948, and the sum of \$10,000 from July 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949. Said sums shall be paid from the general fund of the state and expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said academy.

#### Chapter 176

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for a Dam on the Marsh River.

Dam on Marsh river; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, to be used by the county of Waldo, the town of Winterport and the town of Frankfort to complete the construction of the dam at West Winterport on the Marsh river to protect 3 bridges on said river from RESOLVES, 1947

damage by ice jams, namely: Tibbetts bridge at West Winterport (a 75-ft. steel bridge on a state aid highway), a 200-ft. cement bridge in Frankfort on Highway #1 and a steel bridge in Frankfort near the mouth of the river; said sum shall be taken from the general highway fund and expended under the inspection and supervision of the state highway commission.

#### Chapter 177

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Boothbay.

Town of Boothbay; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Boothbay the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, for the purpose of rebuilding and repairing roads destroyed in the storm of March 2, 1947; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund. Expenditure of the money provided by this resolve shall be under the supervision of the state highway commission and any balance of appropriation remaining unexpended at the end of any fiscal year shall be available for the same on any succeeding fiscal year.

#### Chapter 178

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Hebron.

Town of Hebron; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Hebron, the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948, for the construction and repair of the road leading from state aid road No. 2 at Western Maine Sanatorium to 3rd class road at Eastern Hebron station; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund.
