#### Chapter 37

AN ACT Relating to Equipment in Official Inspection Garages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 36, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 36 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 186 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No application for a license to operate an official inspection station shall be considered unless the garage building to be used as an inspection station shall be of suitable length and width, shall have a level floor, shall be equipped with a screen or chart or other equipment approved by the secretary of state for the purpose of testing lights, and with tools and machinery necessary to make repairs to motor vehicles.'

Effective August 6, 1949

#### Chapter 38

#### AN ACT Relating to Motor Driven Cycles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 19, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

"Motor driven cycle" shall mean every motor-cycle, including every motor scooter, with a motor which produces not to exceed 5 horsepower, and every bicycle with motor attached."

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 19, § 32, amended. The first sentence of section 32 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Every motor vehicle and every motor driven cycle shall be provided with adequate brakes in good working order and sufficient to control such vehicle at all times when the same is in use, and a suitable and adequate horn or other device for signalling.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 19, § 34, amended. The 1st sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 34 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
