Chapter 51

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for State Board of Arbitration and Conciliation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 10, amended. The 6th sentence of section 10 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Members of the board shall each receive \$5 \$20 a day, for their services, for the time actually employed in the discharge of their official duties; they shall also receive their traveling and all other necessary expenses.'

Chapter 52

AN ACT Relating to Analysis of Water.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 121, amended. Section 121 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'The department shall charge the average cost of the analysis for such examination to the person required to have such test made.'
