#### Chapter 88

AN ACT Relating to Credit for Returns of Malt Liquor Bottles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 55, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 55 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Nothing herein contained shall prohibit a licensee from giving credit to a purchaser for the actual price charged for packages or original containers to be returned by the original purchaser as a credit on any sale, or from refunding to a purchaser paying the amount actually paid by such purchaser charged for packages or original containers.'

Effective August 6, 1949 .

#### Chapter 89

AN ACT Relating to Agricultural Societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 16, amended. The 7th sentence of section 16 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 366 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'No society shall receive any portion of the stipend in excess of \$5,000 \$10,000.'

### Chapter 90

AN ACT Relating to Election of Presidential Electors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 4, § 16, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 16 of chapter 4 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'At any such state convention the political party so represented shall formulate and adopt its declaration of principles, or platform, for the state elec-
