'York, \$2,400 \$2,500.'

R. S., c. 79, § 165, amended. That part of section 165 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the sheriff of Lincoln county, as amended by section 4 of chapter 154 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Lincoln, \$1,500 \$1,800,'
