Chapter 179

AN ACT Relative to Extending Hunting Season on Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Whenever the entire state is closed to hunting by proclamation of the governor during the open season on deer, the commissioner of inland fisheries and game with the consent of the governor and council is hereby authorized to extend the open season for deer hunting for a period of not more than 2 weeks, which period shall not total more than $\frac{2}{3}$ of the time lost.'

Chapter 180

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Deeds, Southern District, Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to clerk hire in the office of register of deeds for the southern district, Aroostook county, as amended by chapter 188 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds for the southern district, ~~\$5,200~~ \$6,240 or such amounts as may be allowed by the county commissioners;'

AN ACT Relative to Bounty on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
