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of section 10 over the actual expenditures under the provisions of sections 8 to 25, inclusive, shall, if the governor and council deem it expedient, be paid to the several cities, towns and plantations in proportion to the amount each has paid into the state treasury under the provisions of sections 8 to 25, inclusive.'

Sec. 4. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state to carry out the purposes of this act the sum of \$85,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and the sum of \$85,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951.

Sec. 5. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1949.

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of Various County Officers of Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 6, amended. That part of section 6 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the county commissioners of Franklin county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, ~~\$500~~ \$600.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. That part of section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the clerk of courts of Franklin county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, ~~\$1,750~~ \$2,000.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 79, § 130, amended. That part of section 130 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the county attorney of Franklin county, as amended by section 1 of chapter 161 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, ~~\$950~~ \$1,250.'

Sec. 4. R. S., c. 79, § 146, amended. That part of section 146 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the county treasurer of Franklin county, as amended by section 2 of chapter 161 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, ~~\$800~~ \$900.'

Sec. 5. R. S., c. 79, § 165, amended. That part of section 165 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the sheriff of Franklin county, as amended by section 3 of chapter 161 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, ~~\$1,600~~ \$1,800.'

Sec. 6. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of deeds of Franklin county, as amended by section 4 of chapter 161 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,700.'

Sec. 7. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 5 of chapter 161 of the public laws of 1945 and by section 1 of chapter 371 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Franklin county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$1,200~~ \$1,300; for clerks in the office of register of probate, ~~\$500~~ \$600; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$1,300.'

Sec. 8. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1949.

AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of the Judge of Probate and Register of Probate, Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the judge of probate of Franklin county, as amended by section 7 of chapter 161 of the public laws of 1945 and by section 2 of chapter 371 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Franklin, ~~\$1,000~~ \$1,200.'
