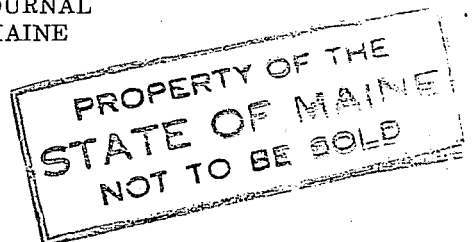

'Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than ~~50~~ \$100 which shall not be suspended.'

Chapter 237

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season in Certain Waters in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 35, amended. Section 35 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraphs, to read as follows:

'It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill or have in possession fish of any kind taken from Aziscohos lake in Oxford county except in the ordinary manner of casting with unbaited artificial flies, or by trolling with unbaited or baited artificial flies or lures.

It shall be unlawful for any person at any time to fish for, take, catch or kill or have in possession fish of any kind taken from any of the tributaries of Aziscohos lake in Oxford county, except Big and Little Magalloway rivers.

It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill or have in possession fish of any kind taken from either Big or Little Magalloway rivers or their tributaries above Aziscohos dam in Oxford county, except in the ordinary manner of casting with unbaited artificial flies, or fly casting, so called.'

Chapter 238

AN ACT Regulating Fishing in Big Magalloway River in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 36, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 36 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
