PUBLIC LAWS, 1949

#### Chapter 254

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Judge of Probate in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the judge of probate in Cumberland county, as amended by section 1 of chapter 240 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Cumberland, \$4,500 \$5,000,'

Effective August 6, 1949

#### Chapter 255

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Sheriff of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 165, amended. That part of section 165 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of sheriff of Hancock county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Hancock, \$2,500 \$2,750,'

### Chapter 256

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of Probate of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 140, § 3, amended. That part of section 3 of chapter 140 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the judge of probate of Waldo county, as amended by section 7 of chapter 322 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Waldo, <del>\$1</del>,<del>500</del> \$1,750,'
