Chapter 286

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Register of Deeds and Clerks in the Office of Register of Deeds, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of register of deeds of Hancock county is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Hancock, ~~\$1,500~~ \$1,800,'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to clerk hire in the office of register of deeds, Hancock county, as amended by chapter 215 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~\$2,500~~ \$3,500;'

Chapter 287

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of Clerk of Courts, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. That part of section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the clerk of courts, Hancock county, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Hancock, ~~\$2,400~~ \$2,600,'
