DIVORCE ACTIONS BY JUSTICE SUPERIOR COURT IN VACATION 265 PUBLIC LAWS, 1949 CHAP. 311

Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1941, c. 81, § 2, repealed. Section 2 of chapter 81 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby repealed.

Chapter 310

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Members of the State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § **5, amended.** The 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th paragraphs of section 5 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 385 of the public laws of 1947, are hereby repealed and the following 4 paragraphs enacted in place thereof:

'On appointment as a trooper, the member shall receive a salary of \$45 per week during the 1st year of service; during the 2nd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$48 per week; during the 3rd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$51 per week; during the 4th year of service he shall receive a salary of \$54 per week and during the 5th year of service and thereafter he shall receive a salary of \$57 per week.

On appointment as a sergeant, the member shall receive a salary of \$59 per week, and thereafter he shall receive an increase in salary of \$1 per week at the beginning of each fiscal year until a maximum salary of \$64 per week is reached.

On appointment as a lieutenant, the member shall receive a salary of \$65 per week, and thereafter he shall receive an increase in salary of \$1 per week at the beginning of each fiscal year until a maximum salary of \$70 per week is reached.

On appointment as a captain, the member shall receive a salary of \$72 per week, and thereafter he shall receive an increase in salary of \$1 per week at the beginning of each fiscal year until a maximum salary of \$75 per week is reached.'

Chapter 311

AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction of Divorce Actions by Justice of Superior Court in Vacation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 153, § 55, amended. The last sentence of section 55 of chapter 153 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The superior court, or any justice thereof in vacation, has jurisdiction of libels for divorce in all counties.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 153, § 61, amended. The last sentence of section 61 of chapter 153 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All libels for divorce shall be in order for hearing at the first or return term, provided service of said libel has been made in accordance with the provisions of this chapter not less than 60 days before said return term, and may be heard by any justice thereof in vacation.'

Chapter 312

AN ACT Relating to Grading of Apples.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 27, § 208, amended. The 3rd paragraph of that part of section 208 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes which is designated "Color Requirements" is hereby amended to read as follows:
