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## Chapter 339

AN ACT Relating to Number of Medical Examiners in Aroostook County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 258, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 258 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The number of medical examiners so to be appointed shall be as follows: for the counties of Franklin, Knox, Lincoln, Piscataquis, Sagadahoc, Somerset and Waldo, 2 each; for the counties of Hancock, Oxford and Washington, 3 each; for the counties of ~~Aroostook~~ Kennebec and York, 4 each; for the ~~county~~ counties of Androscoggin and Aroostook, 5 each; and for the counties of Cumberland and Penobscot, 6 each; and they shall be appointed with reference to territorial distribution.'

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## Chapter 340

AN ACT Relating to the Use of Electrolysis in Beauty Culture.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 22, § 208, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 208 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The use of electrolysis for the removal of hair is not a part of the practice of hairdressing and beauty culture and is prohibited except under the direction of a licensed physician.'

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## Chapter 341

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in County Offices.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., c. 79, § 269-A, additional. Chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 269-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 269-A. Clerk hire in county offices. In all county offices there shall be allowed for clerk hire the amount authorized by statute together
