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but the 1st such meeting shall not be later than November 1, 1949. The board of registration of the town of Bluehill shall prepare and furnish separate check lists for such of the voters within said district as are then legal voters of said town and reside in said district, and all notices, warrants and other proceedings shall be varied accordingly so as to show that only such voters as reside in said district as aforesaid are entitled to vote upon the question. Such special elections shall be called, advertised and conducted according to the law relating to municipal elections; provided, however, that the board of registration shall not be required to prepare nor the town clerk to post a new list of voters; and for the purpose of registration of voters said board shall be in session on the 3 secular days next preceding said election, the 1st and 2nd days thereof to be devoted to registration of voters and the last day to enable the board to verify the correction of said lists and to complete and close up its records of said session. The town clerk shall prepare the required ballots, on which he shall reduce the subject matter of this act to the following question: "Shall the Act to Incorporate the Bluehill Water District be accepted?" and the voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. The result of said election shall be declared by the municipal officers and due certificate thereof filed by the town clerk with the secretary of state.

Chapter 123

AN ACT to Provide for the Election of Trustees of the Canaan School District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Special meeting of Canaan School District, how called; organization of trustees. As soon as may be after the effective date of this act, a special meeting of the Canaan School District shall be called, upon application to a justice of the peace by any 3 inhabitants of said district, for the purpose of electing by a plurality vote of the voters of said district a board of 3 trustees and for the transacting of such other business as may properly come before said meeting. Whereupon such justice of the peace shall call a meeting for such purpose in the same manner as is provided by law for the calling of town meetings. The trustees elected as herein provided shall meet within 7 days after their election and shall organize and determine by lot the term of office of each trustee in the manner provided for in chapter 139 of the private and special laws of 1945.
