Chapter 3

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Orange and Rocky Lakes in the County of Washington.

Regulating fishing in Orange and Rocky lakes in the county of Washington. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Orange lake in the town of Whiting and Rocky lake in the township of Marion and the town of Whiting, in the county of Washington, to ice fishing.

Effective August 6, 1949

Chapter 4

RESOLVE, Opening Thistle Pond in the Town of Monroe, Waldo County, to Ice Fishing.

Opening Thistle pond to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Thistle pond in the town of Monroe, Waldo county, to ice fishing.

Effective August 6, 1949

Chapter 5

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Salt Pond in the Towns of Friendship and Cushing.

Fishing in Salt pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing the daily bag limit of 5 fish per person per day of a minimum length of 8 inches from Salt pond in the towns of Friendship and Cushing, Knox county.
