Chapter 53

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Improve the Approach to the Fish Way at Aroostook Falls.

Resolves, 1947, c. 146, amended. Resolved: That chapter 146 of the resolves of 1947 be, and hereby is, amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘All unexpended balances shall not lapse until June 30, 1951, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1951.’

RESOLVE Reimbursing Certain Towns for Losses Incurred During Forest Fires of 1947.
