Chapter 75

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to Convey the Interest of the State in Certain Land in Township 10, S. D.

Commissioner of inland fisheries and game authorized to convey land. **Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized to convey by a quitclaim deed the interest of the state in a certain lot or parcel of land situate in Township 10, S. D., in the county of Hancock, bounded and described as follows: This parcel of land situated on the north shore of Tunk pond and east of Tunk Stream Outlet, a more definite description as follows: Bounded on the east by state of Maine property line; on south by Tunk pond; on west by Tunk Stream Outlet; and on the north by a line drawn parallel to the state highway from a point 100 feet from shore of said Tunk pond along east bank of outlet until it intersects the state of Maine property line on the east containing $\frac{1}{2}$ acre, more or less.

Chapter 76

RESOLVE Authorizing the State Normal School and Teachers' College Board to Convey Certain Land in Fort Kent.

Certain land in Fort Kent; conveyance authorized. **Resolved:** That the State Normal School and Teachers' College Board be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to convey by quitclaim deed to William L. Michaud of Fort Kent, the interest of the state in a certain piece or parcel of land, known as Lot No. 18, on the northeasterly side of Pleasant street, in the town of Fort Kent, bounded and described as follows, to wit:

Commencing at an iron pin at the easterly corner of Lot No. 17 (Alphe H. Daigle map, 1948), presently owned by the grantee, thence northeasterly on the Bangor and Aroostook railroad right-of-way one hundred nine and eight-tenths (109.8) feet to an iron pin; thence northwesterly parallel to Pleasant street two hundred twenty-nine and seven-tenths (229.7) feet to a point on the right-of-way on the easterly side of the old high school lot; thence southwesterly sixty-six (66) feet to the northwest corner of Lot No. 17; thence southeasterly along the line of the land of the grantee one hundred forty-two (142) feet to the place of beginning.
