## Chapter 115

### RESOLVE, in Favor of Cyr Plantation.

**Cyr plantation; appropriation for. Resolved:** That the money appropriated in favor of Cyr plantation by the 93rd legislature for the repairing of the Daigle road, so called; being a continuation of work done under previous special resolve, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended during the fiscal years ending June 30, 1950 and June 30, 1951, as follows:

\$200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and \$200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, to aid in repairing the Madore road, so called; this being a continuation of work done under previous special resolve.

## Chapter 116

### RESOLVE, in Favor of Hamlin Plantation.

**Hamlin plantation; appropriation for. Resolved:** That the money appropriated in favor of Hamlin plantation by the 93rd legislature for the repairing of the Daigle road, so called, being a continuation of work done under previous special resolve be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended during the fiscal years ending June 30, 1950 and June 30, 1951, as follows:

\$200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and \$200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, to aid in repairing the Remi Cyr road, so called, beginning where repairing ended under previous special resolve and continuing in a southerly direction toward the intersection of the Roy road, so called.
