RESOLVES, 1949

Chapter 152

RESOLVE, in Favor of Madelyn Ames, of East Poland.

Madelyn Ames; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$73.20 to be paid to Madelyn Ames, of East Poland, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the state for rabbits killed by dogs; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

Effective August 6, 1949

Chapter 153

RESOLVE, in Favor of Herman I. Ham of Madison.

Herman I. Ham; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$74 to be paid to Herman I. Ham, of Madison, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for 37 fowl killed by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

Effective August 6, 1949

Chapter 154

RESOLVE, in Favor of Prentiss Plantation.

Prentiss Plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$484.80 be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Prentiss Plantation to reimburse the said plantation for money due it since 1938 under the provisions of section 201 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, said sum to be paid from the appropriation of the department of education.

Effective August 6, 1949

Chapter 155

RESOLVE, in Favor of Leslie W. Jones of West Minot.

Leslie Jones; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$95.29 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Leslie W. Jones of West Minot, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by 2 inmates of the reformatory for men at South Windham.

Effective August 6, 1949
