RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Jefferson.

Town of Jefferson; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$384 from the funds of the department of education to be paid to the town of Jefferson to reimburse said town for transportation of school children who were boarded by the state.

RESOLVE, in Favor of Edward D. McKeon of Kennebunk.

Rogers of Brunswick, to reimburse him for hospital and medical expenses paid by him for his son, Norman Rogers, who became ill while in the National Guard; such appropriation to be paid from the funds of the adjutant general's department.
