Chapter 163

RESOLVE, in Favor of Frederick C. Osgood, of Cumberland.

Frederick C. Osgood; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$167.50 to be paid to Frederick C. Osgood, of Cumberland, to reimburse him for inheritance taxes erroneously paid.

Chapter 164

RESOLVE, in Favor of Susan M. Osgood, of Cumberland.

Susan M. Osgood; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$251.07 to be paid to Susan M. Osgood, of Cumberland, to reimburse her for inheritance taxes erroneously paid.

Chapter 165

RESOLVE, in Favor of John P. Clark, of Scarborough.

John P. Clark; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$300 to be paid to John P. Clark, of Scarborough, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damages on his land for timber cut on and removed from his land in Whitefield.

Chapter 166

RESOLVE, in Favor of Eugene Jorgensen, of South Windham.

Eugene Jorgensen; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$200 to be paid to Eugene Jorgensen of South Windham, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damages to his car caused by its use by escapees from the State Reformatory for Men; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.
