Chapter 171

RESOLVE, in Favor of George L. Varney, of New Gloucester.

George L. Varney; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,500 to be paid to George L. Varney, of New Gloucester, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for loss by fire of a barn and out buildings, including contents, which fire was set by an inmate of the Pownal state school; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

Chapter 172

RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Donnell's Pond in the Town of Franklin in the County of Hancock.

Outlet of Donnell's Pond; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Donnell's pond in the town of Franklin, Hancock county, for the purpose of raising the height of the screen and dam; provided, however, that the town of Franklin shall assume all liability for maintaining said screen and the keeping of said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the state shall be liable for only $\frac{1}{2}$ the cost of said screen.

Chapter 173

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Columbia.

Town of Columbia; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Columbia, in the county of Washington, the sum of \$98.26 from the general highway fund, this being the state's share for snow removal for the fiscal year 1944-45.
