#### Chapter 174

RESOLVE, Authorizing State Highway Commission to Study Desirability of a Bridge Across the Penobscot River.

Bridge across Penobscot river; study authorized. Resolved: That the state highway commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a highway bridge across the Penobscot river between the cities of Bangor and Brewer, in the county of Penobscot, with necessary highway approaches thereto; and be it further

Resolved: That the commission shall report the results of their study at the next regular session of the legislature.

Effective August 6, 1949

#### Chapter 175

RESOLVE, Providing for a Dam and Fish Screen at Chain-of-Ponds, in the County of Franklin.

Chain-of-Ponds; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$6,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for the purpose of installing a dam and fish screen at Chain-of-Ponds, T. 2, R. 6, in the county of Franklin; provided, however, that the Megantic Club, Inc. shall assume all liability for maintaining said screen and the keeping of said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the state shall be liable for only ½ the cost of said dam and screen.

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Long and Square Lakes in the County of Aroostook.

Regulating fishing in Long and Square Lakes in the county of Aroostook. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Long lake, in Saint Agatha and T. 17, R. 3 and 4, W. E. L. S. and Square
